MEMORANDUM & ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION OF

THE BILLIARDS AND SNOOKER FEDERATION OF INDIA

(Amended as on 21.04.2022)

PART – I

1. NAME:

The Name of the Federation shall be 'THE BILLIARDS AND SNOOKER FEDERATION OF INDIA', hereinafter called the 'Federation'.

2. **JURISDICTION:**

The Jurisdiction of the federation shall extend over all States/Union Territories currently existing in India, as well as on any and all new States/Union Territories created within India, in the future.

3. **HEAD QUARTERS:**

The Head Quarters/Registered Office of the Federation shall be located in Indore, Madhya Pradesh State, till such time if a change is voted for and agreed upon by a two-third majority of members (eligible to vote) at an Annual General Meeting or an Extra-Ordinary General Meeting.

4. **AIMS AND OBJECTS:**

The Aims and Objects of the Federation shall be:

- (a) To act as the sole controlling body for Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games in India.
- (b) To foster, encourage and stimulate interest and diffuse knowledge in the game of Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball,

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Pool and any other recognized games played on a Billiard/Pool Table.

- To subscribe to and become a member of the International (c) Controlling Body and/or any other recognized body within the country or elsewhere.
- To endeavor to maintain a high standard in playing of (d) Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games.
- To establish and maintain institutions and centers for (e) imparting knowledge, training and coaching facilities. In this context, the Federation will have powers to recognize and/or appoint coach/coaches as the exigencies of the time may demand for better standards of the game of Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games.
- (f) To formulate and amend Rules, Regulations and Bye-laws, if any, for the proper conduct and organization of Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games.
- To approve of the specifications of the table, pockets and (g) balls and other requisite accessories of the game of Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games.
- To examine, certify and ratify or reject and State and (h) National Records with respect to the game of Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games and if found necessary, to modify such records.
- (i) To adjudicate on any difference and/or disputes in the interpretation of the Rules to prevent any infringement thereof.

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- (i) To promote National Championship in Billiards and Snooker annually and to delegate the Championships to different Affiliated States as far as it is practicable.
- To encourage the concept of other 'OPEN' Championships (k) with a view to promote the games of Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and shall endeavour to conduct at least two competitions annually for Men/Women at the junior and sub-junior levels through Inter district Competitions in each State which will lead to the competition at the National Level.
- (1) To grant Affiliation to States/Union Territories and assist in establishing and forming such Associations with a view to spread and propagate the game of Billiards, Snooker and allied games all over India, and help the affiliated State Bodies to further affiliate at least 50% of the Districts.
- To arrange through Government or recognized private (m) agencies or through direct import, cloth for Billiards Tables, Billiards and Snooker Balls and such other accessories required for use in Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games and supply these items to members whenever required on terms and conditions to be decided by the Federation from time to time.
- (n) To provide funds for:
 - (i) Payment of Affiliation Fees to The International Controlling Body and the Asian Controlling Body.
 - (ii) The expenses of the Federation.

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- (iii) Organizing and conducting Billiards, Snooker. Carrom Ball and Pool Championships from time to time and seek Government funds, for the same.
- Issuing, acquiring, distributing, selling or otherwise (iv) circulating literature on Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games and to have a Library of its own.
- (v) To provide for the expenses of sending one or more representatives to meetings and/or one or more to participate in representatives International Competitions or Championships and to invite foreign players. The persons so nominated to attend meetings or to participate in the Competitions shall be at the sole discretion of the Managing Committee.
- To manage all funds of the Federation and to invest (vi) the Funds, not immediately required, as may from time to time be determined by the Managing Committee.
- To arrange/hold conferences, demonstrations, (vii) exhibitions, meetings, lectures, discussions and benefit shows and to do all acts and things necessary to promote Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games in India.
- To act as Trustees of any funds, trophies or other (viii) properties settled or donated for the promotion or encouragement of Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games.

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(ix) To consider grants and donations to deserving causes, and to accept grants and donations in cash or kind.

5. **DISSOLUTION**:

If upon the dissolution of the Federation there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Federation or any of them but shall be given or transferred to some other Institution(s), having Objectives similar to the Objectives of the Federation, and the same shall be determined either by voting, by not less than two-thirds of the members present and voting, at the time of dissolution, or in default thereof by a Principal Court having Original Civil Jurisdiction in India.

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Rules & Regulations

PART – II

1. **MANAGEMENT:**

- THE BILLIARDS & SNOOKER FEDERATION OF INDIA shall (A) be governed by a Managing Committee, which shall consist of:
 - (i) The President
 - The Four Vice-Presidents (ii)
 - (iii) The Honorary Treasurer
 - (iv) The Secretary General
 - (v) A representative, nominated by each of the Affiliated States [See Article 2 (a)]
 - (vi) Two players, one Male and one Female, to be made members of the Managing Committee with voting rights. That such members shall be nominated by the Federation, and the said Nominations shall be sent to the Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, for approval, in terms of Clause 3.20. of the Guidelines for Recognition of national Sports Federations, as contained in the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011.
- (B) THE BILLIARDS & SNOOKER FEDERATION OF INDIA shall have an Executive Committee to conduct its Day-to-Day activities, which shall consist of:
 - The President; (i)
 - (ii) The Four Vice -Presidents;

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- (iii) The Honorary Treasurer;
- (iv) The Secretary General.

2. <u>MEMBERSHIP</u>:

Membership of the Federation shall be open to:

- (a) State/Union Territories Associations who shall be eligible for Permanent Membership.
- (b) Services, Railways Sports Control Boards, Petroleum Sports Promotion Board, or any other Sports Control Board shall only be eligible for Associate Membership.

The Membership of the Managing Committee shall only be given to those members of the Federation who have a right to vote in the Managing Committee of the Federation, in terms of Clause 3.9. of the Guidelines for Recognition of National Sports Federations, as contained in the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011.

3. <u>APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP</u>:

(a) Application for Affiliation / and Membership must be made in writing to the Federation. Any State or Person/Individual desirous of becoming a member of the Federation shall be duly proposed by one member. Every application for Affiliation / Membership shall be subject to acceptance by the Managing Committee. Consequent to the acceptance of an Affiliation / Membership, the concerned State Body or Person/Individual shall be duly notified of the decision in writing. In the case of non-acceptance, it shall not be necessary to assign any reason for such non-acceptance.

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- (b) States whose application has been rejected, shall not again be proposed for membership to the Federation until after the expiration of six months from the date of the Last rejection.
- (c) Fees:

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(i) States - Rs. 20,000/- (Annual Affiliation Fee.)
(ii) Sports Control Boards - Rs. 1,00,000/- (Annual Affiliation Fee.)
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Annual Affiliation fees shall be payable on membership and fees for the ensuing year shall fall due on the 1st of April of each year.

The above Affiliation fees may be altered from time to time by the Managing Committee.

4. <u>States, Services, Sports Control Board, Railway</u> <u>Sports</u>:

Membership shall be open to all States, Union Territories, Services Sports Control Board, Railways Sports Control Board, Petroleum Sports Promotion Board and Similar bodies within India as may be geographically defined by the Government of India from time to time. All affiliated States must make every effort to encourage Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and Allied games within their respective territories. Only one affiliation from each State and Union Territory will be permitted, and that they shall be granted Affiliation as a Permanent Member subject to payment of an Annual Affiliation Fee of Rs. 20,000/-¹ payable every year. That the various Sports Promotion Board(s) like the

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Services Sports Control Board, Railways Sports Control Board, Petroleum Sports Promotion Board shall be granted Affiliation as an Associate Member subject to payment of an Annual Affiliation Fee of Rs. 1,00,000/-² payable every year. The membership shall be subject to Clause 3.9. of the Guidelines for Recognition of National Sports Federations, as contained in the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011.

Provided that the membership of an affiliated State shall automatically stand terminated if the State does not participate in any National Championship consecutively for three years.

Provided that if any State has two Associations or more as rival associations in any State, which challenges the representative character of the affiliated States Association, the Federation shall decide, which State Association to recognize, after a proper enquiry conducted by an official of the Managing Committee or by a Sub-Committee, constituted for the said purpose by the Managing Committee, and take a final decision.

5. <u>Functions of the President</u>:

The President shall be the Chief Executive of the Federation and shall generally guide and oversee the functioning of the Office Bearers, and lay down policies subject to the guidance and approval of the Managing Committee. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Federation including the Managing Committee and take such action and perform such other duties as may be decided by the Managing Committee. In case of any tie in any meeting, **The President** shall have **the** casting vote. The

President shall also delegate powers to the Vice-Presidents for specific purposes to function as his representative.

However the voting rights of the President will not apply to the elections of BSFI.

6. **FUNCTIONS OF VICE PRESIDENT:**

One of the Vice-Presidents, nominated by the President, shall have the power to perform the duties of the President in the latter's absence. In such an event the Vice-President, so nominated, shall have the casting vote. In absence of the Presidents and Vice-Presidents, the members present shall elect one of the members present to act as Chairman of the Meeting.

The Vice-Presidents shall perform all such duties relating to the Conduct of the Business of the Managing Committee and/or the Executive Committee, as well as any other functions related to the Organization of Tournaments, or the holding of Exhibition, Conferences and any other task/duty/function as may be assigned to them by the Managing Committee and/or the President, from time to time.

7. <u>FUNCTIONS OF HONORARY TREASURER</u>:

The Honorary Treasurer (Elected Office Bearer) shall be custodian of all monies of the Federation. The Treasurer establishes annually a budget that observes the total probable income and expenditure of the BSFI, and after adoption of the budget by the Managing Committee, the Managing Committee shall work within this frame. Shifting within this budget is allowed with the permission of the President in consultation with the Managing

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Committee. The Annual Accounts together with the report of the auditors will be reported to the Managing Committee for approval.

In that capacity he shall be entitled to:

- Disburse payments as approved by the Managing Committee. (a)
- Spend such sum of money as the occasion may demand (b) subject to the approval of the Managing Committee and in consultation with the President or Secretary General.
- Incur recurring valid expenditure such as establishment, (c) salary and other approved contingent expenditure.
- Maintain Imprest money (quantum whereof shall be decided (d) by the Managing Committee from time to time) to meet miscellaneous and other contingent expenditure.
- Submit an abstract statement of quarterly income and (e) expenditure to the Managing Committee in its quarterly meetings.

8. **FUNCTIONS OF SECRETARY GENERAL:**

- Be custodian of all assets of the Federation in whatever form i) they are.
- Keep control over the records, books and available securities ii) of the Federation.
- Maintain up-to-date records of membership and send notice iii) of meetings, records and preserve minutes of such meetings.
- Conduct the correspondence and perform such other duties iv) on behalf of the Federation as ordinarily pertains to the office and as may be entrusted to him by the Managing Committee.
- Be entitled to incur valid expenditures. v)

9. **DUTIES AND PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS:**

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- (i) Affiliated 'States' must in the opinion of the Managing Committee be and continue to be fully representative bodies of the majority of the Regions, Districts, Clubs and Institutions within their State. They shall promote the activity of Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games and hold Annual Competitions in Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool. They shall have the words "Affiliated to the Billiards & Snooker Federation of India", inserted on letterheads and on all notices of their competitions, programs, entry forms etc. They shall submit a copy of their Annual Report and Audited Statement of Accounts to the Federation for information and record. They shall pay the prescribed fees annually and remain constituted as Affiliated States.
- All persons attending and/or voting at such Meetings of the (ii) Federation as the representatives of Affiliated States, shall be bonafide Members of such bodies, and previous to the meeting they shall produce an authority letter signed by the President or Honorary Secretary or Joint Honorary Secretaries of the nominating State Body, to this effect, authorizing the nominated Members to attend and vote at the particular Meeting.
- (iii) Affiliated States shall lose the right to vote at the Annual General and Extra Ordinary General Meetings, if they have not paid their respective Annual Affiliation fees and other dues and outstanding on or before the date fixed for such meeting. They shall also not have the right to vote at any subsequent meeting of the Federation unless they have paid their respective Annual Application fees and arrears if any,

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and unless such delay has been condoned by the Managing Committee.

10. ELECTION OF THE OFFICE BEARERS OF THE MANAGING **COMMITTEE:**

That the election of the office bearers i.e. the President, the Four Vice-Presidents, the Secretary General and the Honorary Treasurer; shall be conducted every four years at the Annual General Meeting to be held at the Headquarters of the Federation. The said elected Office Bearers shall constitute and form the Executive Committee.

The Notification for conducting the Elections shall be issued at least two (02) months before the completion of the tenure of the Existing Managing Committee. The date and time for the conduct of Polls shall be subject to the rules prescribed under Clause 26 of the Rules and Regulations, for calling an Annual General Meeting. As soon as possible, either before/after the issue of the Notification for the Conduct of Elections to the Managing Committee, the President of the Federation, shall nominate a person as Returning Officer for conduct of Election of Office Bearers of the Managing Committee of the Federation. The Returning Officer so appointed shall be an Independent Person, and not be a person who is currently or has in the past been associated with either this Federation, or any of the Affiliated States/Union Territories Bodies/Boards/ Institutions, or with any serving/past Officer Bearer.

The Elections to the above posts may however be deferred, in the event of a force majeure event like a pandemic, court order etc.,

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with the Managing Committee reviewing the situation from time to time.

One (01) post of Vice-President shall be reserved for the election of a Female Candidate. That, however, in the event no Female Candidate is nominated for the reserved position, the said post shall be open to be contested by Male Candidates.

Clause 3.20 of the Sports Code which is as under:

Inclusion of prominent Sportsperson of outstanding merit as members of the respective sports federations on a tenure basis. The strength of such prominent sportspersons with voting rights should be a certain minimum percentage (say 25%) of the total members representing the federation and selection of such sportspersons should be in consultation with this Department.

Inclusion of minimum 25% sportspersons of merit should be adhered, post all elections to the Federation and the same to be reported to Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.

The member(s) elected to Managing Committee of BSFI shall not take part in any recognized National or International tournaments during the term of their office. In case any such person relinquishes his/her office before completion of their term, they would still not participate in any National or International event, till the tenure of the post.

(A) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND PERIOD OF OFFICE:

(i) The term of the office bearers shall be only for a period of four years.

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


- (ii) They shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting by a majority of votes of Members present at voting.
- (iii) Sitting Office bearers are eligible to hold office only for two (02) consecutive terms or eight (08) years. And where Office Bearer(s) are seeking a second term, they shall only be deemed to have been re-elected when elected by not less than two-thirds (2/3rd) Members of the Federation.
- (iv) No office bearer shall be eligible to be the office bearer simultaneously of any other National Sports Association / Federation except the Indian Olympic Association.
- No candidate can contest for any post if he or she is (v) above the age of seventy.
- A Candidate is eligible to hold the post of President for (vi) Three (03)Terms, which may either be held continuously or with breaks, after which the Candidate shall not be eligible to contest for the Post ever again.
- (vii) For the post of Secretary General and Hon. Treasurer a candidate can be elected for two terms continuously after which the candidate can be elected again only after a gap of minimum one term.
- (viii) Serving Civil Servants shall not be eligible to participate/contest the elections to the Managing Committee, without due approval from the concerned Department of the Government in which the Civil

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Servants serve. The said approval has to be taken in terms of the Guidelines set-out in the Sports Code.

- (ix) No Candidate to be nominated for more than one post.
- The Candidates shall hold primary membership of the (x) Affiliated State Bodies.
- The Candidates should either be holding the post of an (xi) Office Bearer in their parent State Bodies or should have in the past held the post of an Office Bearer in their parent State Bodies.

(B) <u>NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION AS</u> OFFICE **BEARERS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE:**

- The nomination of a candidate for election as Office (i) Bearer of the Managing Committee shall be made in Form 2 (Refer to Appendix-II).
- The nomination of a candidate for election as Office (ii) Bearer of Managing Committee shall be proposed by one of the representatives of Member States/Union Territories/ whose name is included in the Electoral College list in Form 1 (Refer to Appendix-I), and also subscribed by 1 (one) such representative as seconder.
- (iii) Each candidate shall be entitled to submit not more than 2 (two) nomination papers.
- (iv) Each Nomination Paper shall be Delivered Personally to the Returning Officer in Person by the candidate himself/herself at the Returning Officer's office, within

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the time frame prescribed in the Notification for the Conduct of Elections to the Managing Committee.

- (v) No person shall be eligible to nominate more than one candidate for the same post, either as proposer or seconder, and, if he so does, his/her signature on the nomination papers delivered second in point of time to the Returning Officer shall be deemed to be inoperative.
- (vi) No person shall be permitted to withdraw his/her name as proposer/seconder, once the nomination paper subscribed by him/her has been delivered to Returning Officer.
- (vii) The Returning Officer shall prepare a list of all nominations received by him/her, post wise, in Form 3 (Refer to Appendix-III); and publish the same in a conspicuous place in his/her office, as per the Timeline prescribed in the Notification for the Conduct of Elections to the Managing Committee.

(C) ELECTORAL COLLEGE:

- Each Permanent Member State/Union Territory duly affiliated by the Federation as its Permanent Member shall have two votes at the elections of the Office Bearers of the Managing Committee.
- (ii) For the purposes of sub-clause (1), each Permanent Member State/Union Territory shall be represented by two members authorized by the President or Secretary General/Secretary of the affiliated Permanent Member State/Union Territory; however, in case

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President/Secretary General/Secretary nominates different person(s), the person(s) authorized by the President shall be deemed to be the duly authorized person(s). Irrespective of the date.

- (iii) Each Permanent Member State/Union Territory shall intimate the name(s) of their representative(s) mentioned in sub-clauses (2) and (3), by the date specified in the notification for conduct of Election, and shall be such intimation addressed to the President/Secretary General of the Federation, on their head duly signed by President/Secretary letter General/ Secretary of that member unit, so as to reach on or before the aforesaid date; any change in the name of any authorized representative after date specified or any intimation received thereafter shall be permitted only with the approval of the President of the Federation.
- (iv) The President/Secretary General the Federation shall prepare the list of the Authorized Representatives of the Member States/Union Territories in Form 1 (Refer Appendix – I), and circulate a copy of the list so prepared by him to all Member States /Union Territories, on or before the date specified in the Notification for the Conduct of Elections to the Managing Committee, by displaying the list on the website of the federation i.e. www.bsfi.net.
- The President / Secretary General shall also furnish a (v) duly authenticated copy of the list mentioned in Subclause (v) to Clause 13(C), to the Returning Officer, as

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soon as possible, after the appointment of the Returning Officer by the President of the Federation.

(vi) That once the list mentioned in Sub-clause (v) to Clause 13(C), has been finalized, only the person(s) mentioned in the said list shall be eligible to vote and that no voting by way of a proxy shall be permitted.

(D) SCRUTINY OF NOMINATIONS:

- (i) On the date and time specified in the Notification for the Conduct of Elections to the Managing Committee, the Returning Officer in his/her office shall scrutinize each nomination paper, one by one, received by him/her, and determine its validity or otherwise.
- (ii) At the time scrutiny of nominations, each candidate either in person or through one of his/her Authorized Representative shall have the right to be present and raise any objection in relation to nomination of a candidate for the post for which he/she has filed his/her nomination.
- (iii) As soon as may be after the scrutiny of all nomination papers has been completed by the Returning Officer, he/she shall prepare a list of validly nominated candidates in Form 4 (Refer to Appendix-IV), and the Contesting Candidates can take a copy from the Returning Officer.

(E) <u>WITHDRAWAL OF NOMINATIONS</u>:

 Each candidate whose nomination has been found valid on scrutiny shall be entitled to withdraw his/her candidature, during the period and time, specified for

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the purpose in Notification for the Conduct of Elections to the Managing Committee.

- (ii) Notice of withdrawal of candidature shall be submitted in Form 5 (Refer to Appendix-V), either by the candidate himself/herself or by a person duly authorized by him/her in writing.
- Notice of withdrawal of candidature shall be final and (iii) shall not be allowed to be cancelled.
- The Returning Officer shall accept the notice of (iv) withdrawal if he is satisfied as to the genuineness of the notice.

(F) LIST OF CONTESTING CANDIDATES:

- As per the timeline prescribed in the Notification for (i) the Conduct of Elections to the Managing Committee, the Returning Officer shall prepare the final list of contesting candidates in Form 6 (Refer to Appendix-VI), display a copy of the said list in conspicuous place in his office and on Federation's Website. And also furnish a copy of the same to each of the candidates/their authorized representatives, if they so demand.
- (ii) The names of the contesting candidates in Form 6 shall be arranged for each post, in alphabetical order according to English alphabets.

(G) UNCONTESTED RETURNS; AND CONTESTED ELECTIONS:

(i) Where the number of contesting candidates for any post or category of post, in Form 6 is equal to the

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number of posts to be filled, all such contesting candidates shall be deemed to be duly elected unopposed to those posts, and it shall not be necessary to conduct a poll for election to such post.

- (ii) Where the number of contesting candidates for any post or category of post, in Form 6, is more than the number of posts to be filled, a poll shall be conducted by secret ballot for those posts, remaining unfilled.
- The ballot papers for these posts remaining unfilled (iii) shall be in Form 7 to Form 10 (Refer to Appendix VII to X) to be made individually for each post.
- (iv) The names of contesting candidates on the ballot papers shall appear in the same order as in Form 6.

(H) CONDUCT OF POLLING:

- (i) The Poll for the Posts Remaining Unfilled shall be taken post-wise on the date and time prescribed in the Notification for the Conduct of Elections to the Managing Committee, and shall commence at during the AGM at the Agenda item Elections.
- (ii) Each contesting candidate can nominate one person, (If he/she so desires), only from amongst the Authorized Representatives list of the Federation, to be present at the Poll (Polling Station)
- At the poll, each authorized representative of Member (iii) States/Union Territories, whose name is included in the Electoral College list in Form 1, shall be entitled to:

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- Cast one vote for each of the posts remaining a. unfilled, where only one such seat is to be filled;
- b. Cast as many votes as are the no. of seats to be filled for any post, where more than one seat is to be filled.

Explanation: It is hereby clarified that for the purpose of filling four seats of Vice-Presidents, each voter can cast up to four votes.

- (iv) In case any voter casts his/her vote for more than one candidate, or for more than four candidates, as the case may be, his/her vote for that post shall be invalid
- Each voter shall be required, before he is supplied with (v) a Ballot paper, to give his/her signature on the authenticated copy of the Electoral College list in Form 1 used by the Returning Officer for taking the poll.
- (vi) The voter shall record his/her vote on the ballot paper in secrecy in a voting compartment specially provided for the purpose at the polling station.
- (vii) The voter shall record his/her vote on the ballot paper by placing a tick mark (\checkmark) against the name of the candidate of his/her choice, and any other mark, like (x) etc. or word, placed on the ballot paper by him/her shall render the ballot paper liable to rejection.
- (viii) The tick mark (\checkmark) to indicate the vote shall be placed by the voter only by means of article specifically provided for the purpose by the Returning Officer, and a ballot paper marked otherwise by means of any pen,

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ball point pen, etc. by the voter shall render the ballot paper liable to rejection.

- (ix) The ballot paper marked by a voter shall be deposited by him/her in a ballot box specially prepared and sealed by the Returning Officer and placed at such a conspicuous place in the polling station that it shall be constantly visible to all present in the polling station.
- (x) The Returning Officer shall close the poll at the appointed hour; however, all those voters who are present at the polling station at the appointed closing hour shall be entitled to vote even if the poll proceedings have to be continued for some more time.
- (xi) After all the voters have voted, the Returning Officer shall close the ballot box and shall not permit thereafter any person to vote.
- Polling will be done in below order: (xii)
 - 1. The President:
 - 2. The Vice Presidents (4);
 - 3. The Secretary General;
 - 4. The Honorary Treasurer.


(I) COUNTING OF VOTES:

- (i) The Returning Officer shall take up the counting of votes as soon as may be after the polling for any post is complete.
- (ii) Each contesting candidate can nominate one Authorized Representative, from among the voters said nominated Authorized present, and the

Representative shall be entitled to be present at the place of counting of votes.

- (iii) The Returning Officer shall take up the counting of votes, post-wise and category wise, where applicable.
- (iv) Each ballot paper on which a vote has been recorded shall be treated as one vote for the candidate for whom it has been validly marked; and if any ballot paper has been marked in violation of the prescribed guidelines, the same shall be rejected by the Returning Officer.
- (v) The votes validly cast for each of the contesting candidates shall be counted post-wise, and categorywise where applicable, and recorded in the descending order of the votes so cast for each candidate in Form 11 (Refer to Appendix XI).
- (vi) The Returning Officer shall thereafter ascertain the result of counting and, the candidates who have secured the maximum no. of votes in the said descending order, post-wise and category wise, where applicable, equal to the no. of seats to be filled for each post or category of posts, where applicable, shall be deemed to have been duly elected to those posts.

(J) <u>DECLARATION OF RESULTS</u>:

The names of contesting candidates who shall be deemed to have been elected at the election shall be declared as having been duly elected to their respective posts, by the Returning Officer at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) in the Form 12 (Refer to Appendix XII).

11. OTHER MEMBERS TO NOMINATION OF THE MANAGING **COMMITTEE:**

The State Bodies Affiliated to the Federation, shall nominate one (01) representative each, to act on their behalf and participate in the functioning of the Managing Committee of the Federation.

12. **APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN AND CEO:**

- The Chairman and/or The CEO will be appointed by the (i) Executive Committee.
- (ii) The Chairman and/or The CEO will be appointed only for the purpose of performing Specific tasks/duties, and shall not have any voting rights.
- (iii) The Tenure of The Chairman and/or The CEO shall be decided at the time of their appointment, by the Executive Committee.

13. VOTING POWERS FOR CONDUCT OF BUSINESS OF THE **FEDERATION:**

The right to vote in the conduct of Business of the Managing Committee, at the Special General Body Meetings, at the Annual General Meetings and Extra Ordinary General Meetings, except for the election of the Office Bearers of the Federation, shall be as follows:

At the Special General Body Meetings and/or Annual (i) General Meetings and/or Extra Ordinary General Meetings, except for election of the Office Bearers of the Federation, the Voting Rights shall be as follows:

- (a) The Affiliated State Bodies shall have one vote each and their duly nominated representative may vote on their behalf;
- (b) The Office Bearers i.e. the President, the Four Vice-Presidents, the Honorary Treasurer and the Secretary General shall have one vote each;
- (ii) At the Managing Committee Meetings, the Voting Rights shall be as follows:
 - (a) The Affiliated State Bodies shall have one vote each and their duly nominated representative may vote on their behalf;
 - (b) The Office Bearers i.e. the President, the Four Vice-Presidents, the Honorary Treasurer and the Secretary General shall have one vote each;
 - (c) The Two Nominated Sportsperson, shall have one vote each;
 - (d) In the event of a Tie, the President shall have the casting vote.

14. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The Executive Committee, shall be responsible for the Day-to-Day functions of the Federation, and shall prepare and formulate policies for the conduct of business of the Federation, such polices shall be placed before the Managing Committee for approval.

15. MANAGING COMMITTEE:

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SUNIL BAJAJ Secretary General



- (i) The Managing Committee shall meet at least four times a year and whenever summoned by the President or under his direction by the Secretary General or on requisition. Three members shall form a quorum. The notice of the meeting of the Managing Committee shall be intimated to each member at least 15 days in advance of the meeting. However, an emergency meeting may be held by giving a Twenty Four Hours' notice. Every member shall be deemed to have been intimated of the notice in the ordinary course if it is sent in time. All matters shall be decided by a majority of vote by a show of hands and in the case of a tie, the designated Chairman (selected from among the members of the Managing Committee) of such a meeting shall have the casting vote.
- (ii) The Secretary General shall keep correct records of the proceedings of all meetings and send a copy of the same to all the members of the Managing Committee along with the agenda of the next meeting.

16. Powers & Duties of the Managing Committee:

The Managing Committee shall in addition to the powers and duties prescribed elsewhere shall have the following other powers:

- (i) Accept or reject membership without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- (ii) Control the finance of the Federation.
- (iii) Enforce the Rules, Regulation and Bye-laws, if any, of the Federation and ensure from time to time that such Rules, Regulation and Bye-laws, if any, are fully complied with.

- Engage or appoint officers, clerks and servants of the (iv) Federation and to remove, demote or dismiss them or vary or alter the conditions of service from time to time in such manner as it thinks.
- Collect funds for the Federation, in cash or kind. (v)
- Secure by purchase, lease, gift or otherwise property (vi) (movable or immovable) for one or more of the objects of the federation.
- Adjudicate an application and appeals from the decision of (vii) States or on disputes between States, and any other matter referred to the Federation concerning the same.
- (viii) Take necessary disciplinary action against Affiliated States, their Officials, and also Players participating in National and International tournaments and Life Members of federation, as per the Bye-Laws of the federation for indulging in conduct which is prejudicial to the interest of the Federation and for the aforesaid purpose to make an enquiry into the same and, if found guilty to remove and/or expel such member. The Managing Committee has the duty to settle conflicts for which it is competent according to the Bye-Laws of the Federation.
- (ix) To enforce the Accreditation Policy, formulated by the federation, upon all the players and officials representing their states in National and International events.
- Formulate, Publish and Enforce a Uniform set of Rules & (x) Regulations, for the Control and Guidance of competitions, exhibitions in Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and


allied games in India and deal with any infringement thereof.

- Register and recognize tournaments and exhibitions in (xi) Billiards, Snooker, Carrom Ball, Pool and allied games of an All-India nature, organized by States, and if necessary, levy fees for such registration.
- (xii) Take any such other steps as may be necessary for the discharge of any of its duties.
- (xiii) Be the sole interpreter of the Articles, Rules, Regulations and Bye-laws, if and of the Federation and decide matters not included therein.
- To organize benefit shows and charity matches/ shows, (xiv) donation, to any national or similar calamities or deserving and meritorious causes.
- The decisions of the Managing Committee in all cases shall (xv) be final and binding.
- To frame rules for payment of travelling and other (xvi) allowance to the office bearers and members of the Federation from time to time for specific purposes and for attending the meeting of the Managing Committee and subcommittee. The Managing Committee may also spend suitable amounts at their own discretion to coaching schemes sponsored by it directly or through the States for the conduct of the coaching camps and for the encouragement of promising and talented players.
- (xvii) The BSFI observes strict neutrality on political, social and religious grounds. No discrimination is permitted against

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any affiliated State association or any association, club, or sportsman on political, racial, or religious grounds.

(xviii) The Managing Committee shall have powers to seek overdraft arrangements from the bankers of the Federation against the fixed deposits for specific periods and for valid reasons. Such overdrafts shall be in a special resolution of the Managing Committee and all efforts shall be made to clear the overdrafts as soon as possible after the purpose of the overdraft has been served.

17. ENFORCEMENT OF RULES:

Acceptance of membership or affiliation to the Federation shall bind each Member of Affiliated States to conform to the Memorandum, Articles of Association, Rules and Regulation and Bye-laws, if any, of the Federation and to accept all decisions of the Managing Committee.

18. ADDRESS AND CHANGES THEREOF:

It shall be the duty of all States and Members to inform the Secretary General in writing of their addresses, phone numbers, email ids or any changes thereof, to which communications may be sent. Any communication sent by post, courier or email at the last address as registered with the Federation, shall be deemed to have been delivered. Communication of an important nature shall be posted under 'Certificate of Posting' or by 'Registered Post' or by E-mail.

19. <u>Termination of Membership</u>:

- (i) An affiliated State Body shall cease to be a member of the Federation if it voluntarily resigns through a duly passed resolution of the State Association by giving one month's notice in writing, addressed to the Secretary General without prejudice to the Federations' right to recover any dues payable by such member of the Federation or if it does not participate in the Nationals for a continuous period of 3 years.
- (ii) If any member fails to pay any amount due to the Federation before the next Annual General Meeting whether formally demanded or not, the name of such member shall be removed from the Register of Members, or if it ceased to be a member by not participating in Nationals as provided in 19(a) above. But such member may be admitted without formalities of a new membership, on payment of all arrears and assigning to the Managing Committee valid reason for failure to participate in the three Nationals which the Managing Committee at its discretion may consider as satisfactory.

20. FINANCIAL YEAR:

The Financial year of the Federation shall end on 31st March of each year.

21. BANK ACCOUNT:

The Bank Accounts of the Federation shall be operated / open by at least two persons i.e. the Honorary Treasurer, the President and the Secretary General or any other member of the Managing Committee so nominated. Receipts shall be signed by the Honorary Treasurer only or in his absence by the Secretary

General or any other person duly authorized by the President or the Managing Committee.

22. **AUDIT:**

Every year the accounts of the Federation shall be examined and audited by a recognized qualified auditor or auditors dulyappointed at the Annual General Meeting.

23. **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING AND NOTICE:**

The Annual General Meeting of the Federation shall be held within six months of the close of the Financial year, on a date and time and at the Headquarters of the Federation. Twenty One (21) Days' notice, of such meeting shall be given. At the Annual General Meeting the following business shall be transacted:

- i) To receive and adopt the minutes of the previous General Meeting or Extra Ordinary General Meeting, copies of which has been approved by the Managing Committee and been circulated with the notice of the meeting.
- ii) a. To receive and adopt the Annual Report of the Secretary General. b. To receive and adopt the Audited Statement of Accounts for the previous year.
- To appoint the statutory Auditor or Auditors and to fix their iii) remuneration, if any.
- To consider recommendations and resolutions of the iv) Committee, if any.

- To consider any motion, notice of which has been given to v) the Secretary General by a member or a representative 7 clear days before the date of the meeting.
- Any other business with the permission of the Chairman. vi)
- To elect Office Bearers of the Managing Committee in terms vii) of the procedure prescribed under Clause 13 of the Rules and Regulation, for a term of four years. Hence outgoing Office Bearers will not have individual voting rights.
- viii) THE QUORUM of the Annual General Meeting shall be 7 (Seven) members present and entitled to vote. If a quorum be not present, the meeting shall stand adjourned for 30 minutes and held thereafter at the same place and if at such an adjourned meeting a quorum is still not present, those who are present shall constitute a quorum but shall transact only the business for which the meeting was called.

24. **EXTRA ORDINARY GENERAL MEETING:**

The President or the Executive Committee may call an Extra Ordinary General Meeting on its own initiative or on a requisition in writing to the Secretary General signed by 10 (Ten) members specifying the particular object for which the meeting is to be called. Such meetings shall be convened within Forty Five (45) Days of receipt of such requisition and at least Twenty One (21) Days' notice shall be given to every member. At such meeting no proposition shall be considered except that relating to the particular object for which the meeting has been convened. The quorum for an Extra Ordinary general Meeting shall be 7 (Seven)

Members present and eligible to vote. If there be no quorum at the time fixed for the meeting it shall stand adjourned to 30 minutes later on the same day and place and if at this adjourned meeting a quorum is not present, the requisitioned meeting shall stand cancelled.

25. <u>No Confidence Motion</u>:

A no confidence motion may be moved against any Office Bearer(s) of the Federation by at least 40% of the Members of the Federation by giving a notice. Such notice shall be sent to the Federation or the Secretary General, who shall convene the Extra Ordinary General Meeting for the purpose within Forty Five (45) Days of the receipt of such notice. In case the President or the Secretary General failed to convene, such a meeting as aforesaid, the members requisitioning will themselves issue such notice for the meeting as convene the same as provided for convening an Extra Ordinary Meeting under Article 27. The no confidence motion shall be deemed to have been carried if it is passed by a majority of two-third members present and voting. In that case such office bearers shall cease to hold office and vacate the same. The Managing Committee shall have the right to fill the casual vacancies, created on account of a No Confidence Motion having passed, by way of Nomination.

26. <u>INSPECTION OF RECORDS</u>:

Any member of the Federation with prior permission in writing, shall have the right to inspect any record and register of members of the Federation and to take copies thereof. Such inspection and taking of copies shall be allowed in the office of the Federation

only in the presence of the President, Secretary General or Treasurer.

27. **INTERPRETATION:**

The interpretation of the Articles, Rules, Regulations and Byelaws, if any and the Constitution's construction and effect, rests with the Managing Committee and any ruling given by the Managing Committee shall be final and binding on all members.

28. **CONSTITUTIONAL STATUES AND BYE-LAWS:**

- Bye-Laws and Regulations are additional prescriptions to the a. Constitution.
- Bye-Laws may be changed or amended by a simple majority b. of the Managing Committee.
- For modifications of the Constitution 2/3 majority of the c. BSFI Members is necessary.
- d. Regulations may be changed or amended by a simple majority of the Managing Committee to be ratified at the next meeting.

29. SAFE CUSTODY:

The safe custody of the Federation's properties shall be kept in the manner which may from time to time be decided by the Managing Committee.

30. DISPUTES ARISING BETWEEN MEMBERS OF THE FEDERATION:

All disputes arising between the members of Federation are to be resolved through a disciplinary Managing Committee set up for the purpose or through Arbitration, if needed.

31. **EXPULSION**:

Any affiliated State Association or its associated player can be expelled from the BSFI if it:

- (a) Brings disrepute to the BSFI or to the Cue Sports.
- (b) Seriously violates the Constitution, Bye-Laws, Regulations or Managing Committee decisions.
- (c) Does not pay the subscriptions and fees owed to the BSFI after due notice has been given.
- (d) The decision of the Managing Committee shall be final.

32. Amendment to Bye-Laws of The Federation:

Amendment to the bye-laws of the Federation shall be made in compliance with the provisions of the Societies Registration Act, 1860. As per the rules, 21 days special notice and details of amendments to be made shall be sent to all members through Email, and the amendment will be sent to Registrar within 30 days from the date of the Special Meeting.

33. <u>Beneficiaries</u>:

The Beneficiaries of the Federation shall be persons who have obtained membership fulfilling eligibility criteria as provided below:

- a. Renowned sports persons who have been provided life time membership and membership of honour.
- b. State Affiliations, services and railways sports control boards and union territories associations. Representatives of other sports organizations who have been provided membership.
- c. Association of persons, and other institutions who enjoy exemptions under exempt under section 2(15), 11, 12, 12A, 12AA, 13 and other applicable provisions of Income Tax Act 1961.

34. <u>Utilization of the Funds of the Federation</u>:

- a. The funds and the income of Federation shall be solely utilized towards the achievement of the objects of the Federation and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to Federation members by way of profit, interest, dividend or loans.
- b. No part of the funds of the Federation shall be utilized for the activities that contravene the objects of the Federation.

35. <u>ATHLETES COMMISSION</u>:

An Independent body comprising of three (03) members i.e. the Secretary General and the Two Nominated Sports Person on the Managing Committee, shall be constituted, to work towards the Welfare of Sportspersons. The said members of the Athlete Commission shall have voting rights in the working of the Managing Committee, with each member having one vote each.

36. ETHICS COMMISSION:

An Ethics Commission is to be established to ensure that the administration of the Sports by the Federation is based on ethical practices and fair play. The responsibilities shall include actions to be taken to Eliminate practices such as Doping, Match Fixing, Age Fraud, and Sexual Harassment, and for dealing with matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

- (i) That the Ethics Commission shall comprise of nominated members, coaches, eminent athletes and any such other person(s) whom the Managing Committee may deem appropriate.
- (ii) That the term of the members of the Ethics Commission shall be for Four years form the date of election or nomination or the attainment of age of seventy years, whichever is earlier.
